- 1) Flood lights installed over the whole campus...(Nevels Electric)
- 2) 23 updated security cameras, internet, & door mag locks installed...(done by Converged Technology)

- 1) Have a security fence built & installed around the back quarter of the campus where the playground will be located (Independent Metal Craft)
- 2) Design & build a large playground area for homeless children who live here
- 3) Build a full basketball court for the children & teens (w/ 2 goals)
- 4) For picking up food, furniture, & sup plies, the ministry needs a full-size pick-up truck. Our old one spends more time in the shop than on the road serving people.

Converged Technology pulled cables for 23 cameras, set up an alarm system, & updated the internet.
