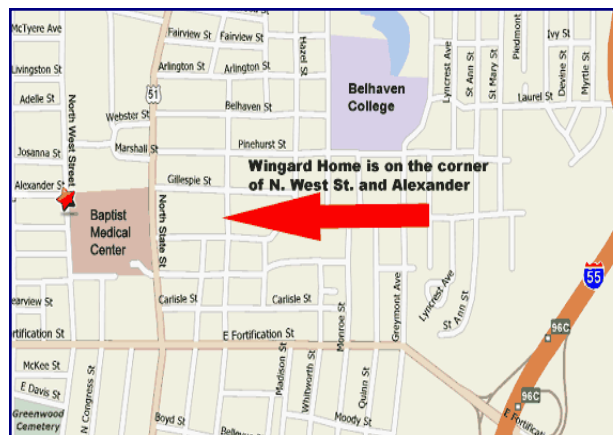
ACCEPTING THE CHALLENGE

Wingard Home Ministries moved to Jackson, Mississippi in October of 1990.

In Jackson, our programs include:

- ⇒ Three Transitional dormitories on campus
- ⇒ Housing for fathers w/children, mothers w/older male children, married couples (with or without children), as well as battered women, run-aways, pregnant teens, & victims of human trafficking.
- ⇒ All our educational programs are Bible based.
- ⇒ Storehouse—our “clothes closet” and so much more for homeless & needy families
- ⇒ Christmas program that targets hundreds of needy children & their families in the area, as well as providing family Christmas for all the homeless folks on the Wingard Home Ministry Campus.
- ⇒ Volunteer program that allows college and high school students to obtain community service hours as they volunteer time & talents.
- ⇒ Provision! When someone works our program and successfully graduates, we help them set-up housekeeping. We give them all the supplies, furniture, appliances, and linens they need to begin independent living! All these blessings to them come from the items you have donated.

Q & A

Are my donations tax deductible?

Yes, indeed! We are registered with the State of MS as a non-profit and have a 501-C-3 number... (20-3861994) from the Federal Government. We gladly give tax-deductible receipt.

Who do you help ?

We house & assist homeless people: women-single, or w/ children, pregnant teens, men-single or w/children, families, & married couples) living in dire straits, displaced, or abandoned. They must be willing & able to secure employment, follow rules, & pass a drug test.

What kinds of donations do you accept?

“We accept anything we can use to help someone get on their feet. We always say, *“anything for a house or a person!”* We gladly accept anything from a pair of shoes to a running vehicle! We also accept cash, checks, gift cards, & (on our web site) you can donate by credit card or set up a monthly auto-pay.

Do you pick up donations?

Yes we do! Picking up things allows us a certain measure of fellowship and blesses the homeless and needy at the same time. Call to schedule. Donations to this ministry are tax deductible.

Do you speak to groups to tell your story?

Yes! We love tell others how Jesus changed our life. Homelessness and addiction are things we know from experience. God has taken all the bad things we allowed in our lives & is using our testimony to minister to others. You just say where and when...we will be there!

How are you funded?

We are funded solely by private donations. We do NOT accept government funding of any type. We DO accept private foundation & corporate grants.
